Musical Tutorial & Piano Rehearsal Studio	The Musical Tutorial Fee (NT\$11,180) and Piano Rehearsal Studio Fee (NT\$1,000) apply to both undergraduate and graduate students in the Department of Music. An additional Musical Tutorial Fee (NT\$7,990) applies to students pursuing a minor or double major in Music. Undergraduate students in a deferred-study condition or graduate students in their third year or beyond are exempt from the Musical Tutorial Fee if they do not take any tutorial courses. Art Skills Tutorial	According to the related regulations, undergraduate students enrolled in the Department of Visual Arts from the Academic Year 2020, including first- and second-year students, as well as non-major students (such as minors and double majors), transfer students, repeaters, and graduate students, are required to pay an Arts Instruction Fee of NT\$2,620 per semester, regardless of the number of credits taken if they take any of the following professional courses: 3D Plastic Arts (I), Watercolor (I), Drawing (I), Basics of Computer Art, Drawing (II), Computer Multi-media Art (I), Design & Construction, Chinese Ink Painting (I), Oil Painting (I), Ceramics (I), Printmaking (I), and Mixed Media.	https://www.ncyu.edu.tw/art/Subject/Detail/35331?nodeId=9510

¹ Tuition and miscellaneous fees apply to all full-time undergraduate programs. For students taking zero credits, the number of credits is calculated based on the class hours of the courses. Starting in 2017, deferred-graduation students who take 9 or fewer credits are still required to pay credit and miscellaneous

fees. The miscellaneous fee is calculated by the number of credits divided by 10 and then the result multiplied with specified miscellaneous fees. For those taking 10 or more credits, tuition and miscellaneous fees should be paid in full.

- ² The following departments—Special Education (including the Master’s Program) and E-Learning Design & Management (including the Master’s Program) in the Teachers College; Music (including the Master’s Program) and Visual Arts (including the Master’s Program) in the College of Humanities and Arts; and Management Information Systems (including the Master’s Program) in the College of Management—are charged fees based on those of the College of Science and Engineering.
- ³ Starting from Academic Year 2025, a pilot project for the University of the Third Age will be offering credit-based special programs, including the “Healthy Farming and Wellness Program,” the “Healthcare and Wellness Program,” and the “Lifestyle and Aesthetic Arts Program.”

- ⁴ Master’s students (including In-service Master's Programs) and doctoral students who have already submitted their theses/dissertations but are unable to graduate due to enrollment in the Teacher Education Program or participation in educational internships are exempted from paying the basic tuition and miscellaneous fees. However, in order to complete the registration process, they are still required to pay the student insurance fee and computer usage fee, as well as fees related to the Teacher Education Program or educational internship guidance in accordance with relevant regulations.
- ⁵ Tuition fees for the In-Service Master’s Program in Department of Civil & Water Resources Engineering:
 - (1) For students admitted in or before Academic Year 2024:
 - Credit Fee: \$3,075
 - Basic Tuition and Miscellaneous of Fees: \$10,250
 - (2) For students admitted in or after Academic Year 2025:
 - Credit Fee: \$4,200
 - Basic Tuition and Miscellaneous of Fees: \$10,250
