Groupon is a deal-of the-day website, working as an assurance contract: a certain number of people must sign up for the offer to make the deal available to all; otherwise, no one gets the deal that day if the predetermined minimum is not met. It creates a new approach to commerce that will change the way we eat and shop and interact with the physical world. Unlike classified advertising, the merchant does not pay any upfront cost to participate. Groupon collects personal information from willing consumers and then only contacts those consumers, primarily by daily email, who may possibly be interested in a particular product or service.

Groupon's breakthrough lies not so much in the deals as an ingredient that is both unlikely and ephemeral: words. Feeling that people may have grown numb to the elements of advertising, Groupon's editors try to mix business with art and create their own voice by borrowing some tools and terms from journalism, softening traditional heavy hand advertising, adding some banter and attitude and then leading the result to a discounted deal.
