

Call for Papers Guidelines for the Journal of Applied History at National Chiayi University

Approved on June 29, 105.

1. The Journal of Applied History (hereafter referred to as the Journal) is an academic publication primarily focused on featuring scholarly articles from lecturers, both full-time and part-time, at domestic and international universities, who hold a position of lecturer or higher, or have obtained a doctoral degree. Contributions should not have been published in other academic journals.
2. The Journal is published irregularly, and submitted manuscripts are reviewed upon receipt. After acceptance, the publication schedule is determined by the Journal's editorial committee.
3. Manuscript formatting should adhere to the guidelines specified in the "Instructions for Manuscript Preparation for the Journal of Applied History at National Chiayi University."
4. Submissions should not be simultaneously submitted to another publication. Manuscripts submitted should be original (including online publications), and for conference papers, authors should confirm that the conference proceedings have not been published. Authors are responsible for obtaining written permission from the original authors or publishers for any copyrighted material (such as images and lengthy quotations). The Journal assumes no responsibility in this regard. Submissions involving copyright infringement or plagiarism will not be considered. Once accepted, authors may not request withdrawal, and publication in other journals is prohibited without the approval of the Journal's editorial committee.
5. Following the editorial system of the Journal, all manuscripts undergo a review process by at least two external scholars or experts in the relevant field. The editorial committee decides on publication based on the review opinions. All manuscripts will not be returned, and authors are advised to keep backup copies.
6. Manuscripts should include the author's name, affiliation, title, phone number, address, and email address for communication purposes.
7. After typesetting, authors are responsible for proofreading their manuscripts.
8. Accepted manuscripts will receive two copies of the current issue of the Journal and the electronic file of the accepted manuscript. No additional remuneration will be provided, and the copyright belongs to the journal.

9. Submission requirements: One electronic copy of the finalized manuscript, one printed copy of the finalized manuscript, and a personal information form (including name, CV, contact number, address, and email).
